Severe Weather – be prepared!

Please keep in a safe place with easy access

As winter approaches, we could get some snow at some point during the next few months which will be great fun for the children!!

You will be informed by text if the school is closed. It will also be advertised on local radio (BBC Berkshire, Heart and 107). Should you need to check, we will also post updates on the website (www.purleyprimaryschool.co.uk). If you do not hear from us, the school is open.

The decision to open or close the school is not an easy one to take. We consider the safety of the children both in the snow conditions and whether we have enough staff to look after them. Please bear with us - we make the decision as early as we possibly can.

If snow is forecast,

- It would be advisable to think what you would do for childcare should the worst happen.
- Pack spare clothes in case you child gets wet during the day - highly likely when building snowmen.
- School Lunches: we may not be able to get the school dinners delivered from Pangbourne so it would be worth sending your child with a packed lunch for that day.
- If it continues to snow during the school day check your phone messages and school website as a decision might be taken to close due to concern that conditions will worsen during the day and school is not the best holiday camp to stay in!



- Access to the school will be via the front gate. We will make sure a path has been gritted all the way to the double-doors opposite the hall. The back gate will be kept shut. Children should come straight into school and remove their boots at the door. They can then swap their boots for normal school shoes or pumps.
- To keep the school open, the start of the day may be delayed to 10.00am to enable staff and children time to travel safely.
- It is unlikely that cars will be able to use the roads near the school. With this in mind, only children and parents who can walk to school should attempt to come in. The children will have great fun playing in the snow on the way to school!
